Mark is now married with 3 children.

He had a fascinating story and we thank all who came to hear him. Next week we are going more local as our speaker is **Mrs Margaret Gill from Clonbollogue**. A member of the Church of Ireland, a mother and a housewife who has known her own troubles, we welcome her and we hope that we will have a great crowd for her.
